### Installation

You must install and charge the handset battery before using the cordless handset. STOP!

See pages 5-7 for easy instructions.

Your product may be shipped with a protective sticker covering the handset display - remove it before use.

### Avoid placing the telephone base too close to:

- Communication devices such as television sets, VCRs, or other cordless telephones.
- Excessive heat sources.
- Noise sources such as a window with traffic outside, motors, microwave ovens, refrigerators, or fluorescent lighting.
- Excessive dust sources such as a workshop or garage.
- Excessive moisture.
- Extremely low temperature.
- Mechanical vibration or shock such as on top of a washing machine or work bench.

## Quick reference guide

#### Charge light

• On when the handset is charging in the charger.

#### Softkeys (2)

• Press to select a menu item displayed above the key.

#### LINE 1/LINE 2/LINE 3/LINE 4

- Press to make a call on the desired line.
- Press to answer a call.

#### INT

• Press to make an intercom call when in idle.

#### **REDIAL/PAUSE**

• Press to view the last 10 numbers dialed.

#### ◄)/SPEAKER

• Press to turn on the handset speakerphone. Press again to resume normal handset use.



## Quick reference guide



#### VOL/ADIR

- Press to scroll up while in menus.
- During a call, press to increase the listening volume.
- Press to show directory entries when the telephone is not in use.

#### MENU/SELECT

- Press to enter the menu.
- While in a menu, press to select an item or save an entry or setting.

#### OFF/CANCEL

- While using menus, press to return to idle mode.
- During a call, press to hang up.

#### VOL/▼CID

- · Press to scroll down while in menus.
- During a call, press to decrease the listening volume.
- Press to show the caller ID history when the telephone is not in use.

#### MUTE/DELETE

- During a call, press to mute the microphone.
- · While predialing, press to delete digits.
- While reviewing the directory entry, press to delete an individual entry.
- While entering or editing a directory entry, press to erase a digit or character.

### Using menus

- Press MENU/SELECT or MENU to show the first menu item, Ringers.
- Press ▲ or ▼ to scroll through menu items.
- Press MENU/SELECT or SELECT to select or save changes to a highlighted menu item.
- Press oFF/CANCEL or BACK to cancel an operation, exit the menu display or return to the idle screen.

## Charger installation

Install the charger as shown below.



### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

- Use only the power adapter supplied with this product. To order a replacement power adapter, visit our website at www.telephones.att.com, or call 1 (800) 222-3111. In Canada, dial 1 (866) 288-4268.
- 2. The power adapter is intended to be correctly oriented in a vertical or floor mount position. The prongs are not designed to hold the plug in place if it is plugged into a ceiling, under-the-table or cabinet outlet.

### Battery installation and charging

Install the battery as shown on the following page. Once you have installed the battery, the screen indicates the battery status (see the table below). If necessary, place the handset in the charger to charge the battery. For best performance, keep the handset in the charger when not in use. The battery is fully charged after 11 hours of continuous charging. See the table on the **Technical specification** page in the user's manual for battery operating times.

If the screen is blank, you need to charge the handset without interruption for at least 30 minutes to give the handset enough charge to use the telephone for a short time. When the battery is low, the handset shows **Low battery** and a flashing  $\hat{\Omega}$ .

Battery indicators	Battery status	Action
The screen is blank or shows <b>Place in charger</b> and $\hat{\Box}$ flashes.	The battery has no or very little charge. The handset cannot be used.	Charge without interruption (at least 30 minutes).
The screen shows Low battery and flashes.	Battery has enough charge to be used for a short time.	Charge without interruption (at least 30 minutes).
The screen shows <b>EXT XX</b> . ( <b>XX</b> represents the extension number of its registered device).	Battery is charged.	To keep the battery charged, place the handset in the charger when not in use.

## Battery installation and charging

Install the battery as shown below.

- 1. Plug the battery connector securely into the socket inside the handset battery compartment. Insert the supplied battery with the label **THIS SIDE UP** facing up as indicated.
- 2. Align the cover flat against the battery compartment, then slide it upwards until it clicks into place.
- 3. Charge the handset by placing it face forward in the charger. The charge light is on when charging.



### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

- Use only the supplied rechargeable battery or replacement battery (model BT164392). To order a replacement battery, visit our website at www.telephones.att.com, or call 1 (800) 222-3111. In Canada, dial 1 (866) 288-4268.
- If you do not use the handset for a long time, disconnect and remove the battery to prevent possible leakage.

### Adding and registering a handset

You must register this MS2025 cordless handset with the MS2085 console or MS2015 deskset before use. Each MS2085 or MS2015 supports only one cordless handset. When first purchased, the handset shows **Choose Handset in Registration at base menu. And put handset on cradle to register**.

If the handset does not have enough power to proceed with the registration, you need to charge the new handset for at least five minutes (see **Battery installation and charging** on pages 6-7). Start registration when the handset screen shows **Choose Handset in Registration at base menu. And put handset on cradle to register**.

## Adding and registering a handset

### To register a handset to your MS2085 console

- 1. Make sure the cordless handset is out of the charger and the screen shows **Choose Handset** in Registration at base menu. And put handset on cradle to register.
- On the MS2085 console, press MENU/SELECT or ►/SKIP.
- 3. Press ▲ or ▼ to scroll to **Registration** then press MENU/SELECT or ►/SKIP.
- 4. Press MENU/SELECT again or press
  ▶/SKIP to select Handset. The MS2085 console screen shows Registering handset... (Put handset on cradle to start).
- 5. Place the unregistered handset into the charger. The handset screen displays **Registering... Please wait** during registration. The handset beeps once and begins registering to the MS2085 console. It takes up to 60 seconds to complete the registration. When the registration is successful, the MS2085 console shows **Handset registered**.

**DNOTE:** If the registration is not successful, the console returns to the previous screen. To reset the handset, remove the handset from the charger. Try the registration process again.

## Adding and registering a handset

### To register a handset to your MS2015 deskset

- 1. Make sure the cordless handset is out of the charger and the screen shows **Choose Handset in Registration at base menu. And put handset on cradle to register**.
- 2. On the MS2015 deskset, press MENU/SELECT or ►/SKIP.
- 3. Press ▲ or ▼ to scroll to **Registration**, then press MENU/SELECT or ►/SKIP.
- Press MENU/SELECT again or ►/SKIP to select Handset. The MS2015 deskset screen shows Registering handset... (Put handset on cradle to start).
- 5. Place the unregistered handset into the charger. The handset screen displays **Registering...** Please wait during registration. The handset beeps once and begins registering to the MS2015 deskset. It takes up to 60 seconds to complete the registration. When the registration is successful, the MS2015 deskset shows Handset registered. To change the handset name and the extension number shown on the handset screen, refer to the Phone rename and Extension number sections in the user's manual of the cordless handset.
